The following are the legal holidays for the calendar year 2025:

Wednesday, January 1, 2025 – New Year’s Day  
Monday, January 20, 2025 – Martin Luther King, Jr. Day  
Monday, February 17, 2025 – Presidents’ Day  
Monday, May 26, 2025 – Memorial Day  
Thursday, June 19, 2025 – Juneteenth Day  
Friday, July 4, 2025 - Independence Day  
Monday, September 1, 2025 - Labor Day  
Monday, October 6, 2025 - Frances Cabrini Day  
Tuesday, November 11, 2025 - Veterans Day  
Thursday, November 27, 2025 - Thanksgiving Day  
Thursday, December 25, 2025 - Christmas Day

Administrative Authorities have the discretion to grant requests for César Chávez Day (March 31, 2025) and Jury Appreciation Day (September 5, 2025) in lieu of another holiday within the same fiscal year. When granting such requests, the administrative authority should consider whether there will be work for the employee to perform for the court or probation department on the recognized legal holiday the employee has asked to work. If Jury Appreciation Day and Labor Day are both on September 5, an employee will only be granted Labor Day.
