## I. Approval of Minutes

## II. Reporter's Update

The Reporter informed the Committee that Thomson Reuters had recently published soft-bound copies of the 2015 edition of the Model Criminal Jury Instructions. The Reporter also informed the Committee that he was in the process of reviewing legislation passed during the 2016 session that might affect the jury instructions.

### III. Future Subcommittee Assignments

The Chair reiterated to the Committee his goal of incorporating all Title 18 offenses into the model jury instructions prior to the end of 2016. The Chair encouraged members to serve on subcommittees over the next few months, with the goal of formally finalizing a number of chapters at each of the September, October, and November meetings.
