I. Approval of Minutes

The Committee approved the minutes for the August 21, 2014, meeting.

II. Reporter's Update

The Reporter informed the Committee that Thomson/Reuters (West) has indicated that it will soon be publishing COLJI-Crim. (2014) in digital and paper formats.

The Reporter briefed the Committee regarding his ongoing drafting work and the continuing legal education presentations he is conducting to help users become acquainted with the instructions.

III. Planning

The Committee agreed to divide into subcommittees and review the Reporter's drafts of several more chapters that were not included in COLJI-Crim. (2014). The subcommittees will present these materials at the April meeting.

In addition to these new chapters, the 2015 edition will include legislative and caselaw updates, as well as corrections or revisions approved by the Committee.

Because the "Reporter's Online Update" is available to alert users to the Reporter's recommended corrections of clear errors, the Committee agreed not to release any type of supplement, or a notice of approved corrections, prior to its publication of the 2015 edition.
