
ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2021-27

ORDER VACATING ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2021-20 IN THE LA PLATA COUNTY
COURTHOUSE

Pursuant to the authority granted to the Chief Judge of the Sixth Judicial District by the Chief Justice of the Colorado Supreme Court in his Updated Order Regarding COVID-19 and the Operation of Colorado State Courts dated May 6, 2021, the Chief Judge of the Sixth Judicial District has determined that due to the significant reduction in the current rate of new COVID-19 infections in La Plata County, the significant reduction in the percentage of positive COVID-19 tests, the current rate of persons in La Plata County over 18 years of age who are fully vaccinated for COVID-19, and the availability for all adults in La Plata County who are already fully vaccinated to receive booster shots to further protect them from COVID-19, the safety concerns that caused the suspension of jury trials in La Plata County have substantially decreased.

Therefore, effective January 6, 2022, Administrative Order 2021-20 is vacated. The judges in La Plata County will be allowed to conduct jury trials as of January 6, 2022, pursuant to the provisions of Administrative Order 2021-12 and Administrative Order 2021-19.
