
ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2018-05

JUVENILE SCREENING PROTOCOL FOR
THE 22ND JUDICIAL DISTRICT

WHEREAS, it is necessary to have a uniform screening process to determine the appropriateness of juveniles for detention placement and that such screening process requires adherence to state guidelines (The Juvenile Detention Screening and Assessment Guide or "JDSAG"), and, furthermore, screeners must receive adequate training in order to properly utilize such instrument, and in view of the recent closure of the Robert E. Denier Youth Services Center, the Court orders that the staff of Hilltop Community Resources in Grand Junction, CO (**Telephone Number 970-244-0619**) are authorized to conduct such screening for cases arising out of the 22nd Judicial District. In addition, the CYDC (formerly Senate Bill 94) Juvenile Services Planning Committee is authorized to enter into such agreements as it may wish to provide screening of juveniles for detention.

This order supersedes Administrative Order 20012-03 as amended on August 23, 2018 which is hereby rescinded.
