CASE MANAGEMENT ORDER (CMO) - INFRACTIONS	

This case has been set for a Final Infraction Hearing.

You are advised of the following:

The hearings are governed by the Colorado Rules for Infractions.

Discovery is not available in Infraction cases. The parties will be required to share evidence/exhibits immediately prior to the hearing.

The Court will allow the parties a few minutes to negotiate the case. The Court does not get involved in those negotiations. If the parties wish to negotiate, parties should appear early to discuss the resolution.

Any request to continue must be filed by motion. Defendants may do this in room S101 in the Clerk's Office. Law Enforcement Personnel may file their motion by providing this with the delivery of tickets to the staff in S105.

Any request to continue must be filed no later than 7 days prior to the scheduled hearing.

Emergency requests to continue may be emailed to the division at [D04 Courts DivN@judicial.state.co.us](mailto:D04_Courts_DivN@judicial.state.co.us). Only emergency requests to continue will be considered. No other filings will be accepted by email.

Court staff will attempt to email continuance Orders to Law Enforcement Personnel. However, this is only a courtesy. Law Enforcement Personnel should check Colorado State Court – Data Access to monitor their cases.

The Court expects parties to be on time. However, due to weather, traffic or Court Security delays, the Court will allow a maximum of 15 minutes for any party to appear.
