FELONY CASES IN COUNTY COURT


ORDER

WHEREAS, C.R.S. § 13-6-106(1)(b) confers the County Court with concurrent statutory jurisdiction with the District Court in certain criminal matters; it does not delineate the determination of competency as one of those matters;

NOW THEREFORE IT IS ORDERED THAT:

If competency is raised in the County Court, the County Court will order a competency evaluation, stay the proceedings of the case, and the case will be bound up to the District Court for all further proceedings. The case should then be set in the District Court in 60-90 days for a return of the competency evaluation.
