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IN THE MATTER OF THE DESIGNATION OF A USEFUL PUBLIC SERVICE  
PROVIDER FOR THE FIRST JUDICIAL DISTRICT

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**ORDER**

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WHEREAS, section 18-1.3-507(2)(a) of the Colorado Revised Statutes provides that a probation department, sentencing court, county sheriff, board of county commissioners, or any other governmental entity, or a private nonprofit or for-profit entity that has a contract with a governmental entity, may establish a community or useful public service program. It is the purpose of the community or useful public service program: To identify and seek the cooperation of governmental entities and political subdivisions thereof, as well as corporations, associations, or charitable trusts, for the purpose of providing community or useful public service jobs; to interview persons who have been ordered by the court to perform community or useful public service and to assign such persons to suitable community or useful public service jobs; and to monitor compliance or noncompliance of such persons in performing community or useful public service assignments within the time established by the court. And,

WHEREAS, the Jefferson County Board of County Commissioners has resolved to establish a useful public service unit within the Justice Services Department.

It is hereby ordered that the Jefferson County Justice Services Department shall be the designated useful public service provider for the courts in the First Judicial District.
