
TICKETS NOT FILED TIMELY WITH THE COURTS

ORDER

Pursuant to Colorado Rules of Criminal Procedure 4.1(c)(3), when a ticket is filed by law enforcement and/or the DMV after the scheduled appearance date, a standardized process has been created to obtain accurate statistics and consistent processing. The Clerk's Office will create a case, send notice to the agency regarding the untimely filing of the summons and complaint, and attach a copy of the ticket to the notice. The case will then be closed and dismissed.

THEREFORE IT IS ORDERED THAT the Clerk of Court in each respective county has authority to dismiss these cases without having to send each case to a Judge for dismissal.
