

## Referral for Court-Ordered Evaluations and Incompetent to Proceed (ITP) Commitments

**Please Note:** Evaluations (Competency, Sanity, Mental Condition) are to address specific questions as described in the statutes. For inpatient commitment ITP defendants, only complete if a CMHIP evaluator did not perform the competency evaluation. If treatment is the primary consideration then the defendant should be considered for civil commitment under CRS 27-65. Evaluations can be ordered to be performed in jail, outpatient in custody of law enforcement, outpatient not in custody or inpatient at the Colorado Mental Health Institute at Pueblo (CMHIP). First consideration should always be given to outpatient evaluations per statute.
