C.R.C.C.P. Form 1. Summons.

This summons is issued pursuant to Rule 303, Rules of County Court Civil Procedure, as amended. A copy of the complaint together with a blank answer form must be served with this summons. This form should not be used where service by publication is desired.

C.R.C.C.P. Form 1A. Summons in Forcible Entry and Unlawful Detainer.

This summons is issued pursuant to Rule 303, Rules of County Court Civil Procedure, as amended, and section 13-40-111, C.R.S. A copy of the complaint <u>together with a blank answer form</u> must | be served with this summons. This form should be used only for actions filed under Colorado's Forcible Entry and Detainer Act.

C.R.C.C.P. Form 1B. Summons for Injunctive Relief for Breach of Restrictive Covenants.

This summons is issued pursuant to Rule 365, Rules of County Court Civil Procedure, as amended. A copy of the complaint <u>together with a blank answer form</u> must be served with this summons. This form should not be used where service by publication is desired.
