Curry Living Trust continues its effort to hire an engineer to prepare site plans for construction of the two ponds and the pump system, and to secure a contractor to build the ponds, assist with installation of the Smith Pump system, and provide guidance regarding requisite measuring devices. To date, Curry Living Trust incurred approximately \$1,500 for legal fees and costs (including filing fees and anticipated publication fees) for the preparation and filing of this Application for Finding of Reasonable Diligence.
