# CHAPTER 29.7 COLORADO COLORADO RULES FOR TRAFFIC INFRACTIONS

#### Rule 6. Payment Before Appearance

- (a) NO CHANGE.
- (b) At the time of payment, the defendant shall sign a waiver of rights and acknowledgment of guilt or liability—form, as set forth <u>inas</u> Form A in the appendix to these rules, and pay a docket fee, and agree to complete any additional court ordered sanction.
  - (c) NO CHANGE.

## Rule 12. Judgment After Final Hearing

- (a) through (b) NO CHANGE.
- (c) If the defendant is found guilty or liable, the referee shall assess the appropriate penalty and the docket fee, and any additional costs authorized by section 13-16-122 (1), C.R.S, and order the completion of any additional court ordered sanctions.
- (d) The judgment shall be satisfied upon payment to the clerk of the total amount assessed as set forth above <u>and performance of additional sanctions</u>.
  - (e) NO CHANGE.

## Rule 16. Default

- (a) through (c) NO CHANGE.
- (d) The defendant may satisfy a judgment entered under this rule by paying the clerk and providing proof of compliance with any additional court orders.
  - (e) NO CHANGE.
