COLORADO RULES OF CRIMINAL PROCEDURE

Rule 17. Subpoena

(e) Service. Unless service is admitted or waived, a subpoena may be served by the sheriff, by his deputy, or by any other person who is not a party and who is not less than eighteen years of age. Service of a subpoena may be made by delivering a copy thereof to the person named. Service may also be made in accordance with section 24-21-204(4), C.R.S. Service is also valid if the person named has signed a written admission or waiver of personal service. If ordered by the court, a fee for one day's attendance and mileage allowed by law shall be tendered to the person named if the person named resides outside the courty of trial.
