Matthew Margeson, District Attorney in and for the Twenty Second Judicial District, State of Colorado, respectfully moves the Court to schedule a setting conference in the abovecaptioned case, in support of this request, the People state as follows:

- 1. On April 19th, 2022, the Court issued an order with regards to the trial date in the above captioned matter.
- 2. The Court set trial for either August 15, 2022 or alternatively August 29, 2022, with an order that the parties were to file notices regarding witness availability within 7 days.
- 3. On April 25, 2022, the People filed notice indicating that absent additional dates being supplied, the People would prefer the August 15th start date.
- 4. On April 27, 2022, the Defense filed notice that neither trial date would be acceptable, noting that witnesses for the defense were unavailable for either trial date.
