**ORDER EXTENDING TEMPORARY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER (TCJO 2020-06)  
AUTHORIZING THE TEMPORARY WAIVER OF CERTAIN FY20 PROBATION  
STANDARDS DUE TO PUBLIC HEALTH CONCERNS RELATED TO COVID-19  
("NOVEL CORONAVIRUS")**

**ISSUED May 12, 2020**

The purpose of TCJO 2020-06 issued on April 13, 2020 is to provide guidance and authority to the 17<sup>th</sup> Judicial District Probation Department regarding operations based on public health concerns related to the novel coronavirus ("COVID-19"). On April 9, 2020, Colorado Supreme Court Chief Justice Nathan Coats issued *Order Regarding COVID-19 and Operation of Colorado State Probation Departments*, providing Chief Judges with the authority to temporarily waive certain FY20 Probation Standards through May 15, 2020. On May 12, 2020 Chief Justice Coats entered an Order extending the April 9, 2020 Order until further directive of the Court.

Therefore, the provisions of TCJO 2020-06 shall continue until further Order of the Chief Judge.
