There appears to be some confusion concerning the line of authority for supervision of the "County Court" Magistrate. This memo is intended to eliminate that confusion.

- 1. The County Court Magistrate is an employee of the Seventeenth Judicial District and not an employee of the county court judges.
- 2. I have authorized the Presiding County Court Judge to supervise the daily activities of the Magistrate.
- 3. No other judge shall interfere with or attempt to supervise the Magistrate or his staff. The Magistrate is not accountable or answerable to any county court judge other than the Presiding County Court Judge.
- 4. Any appeal concerning supervisory decisions shall be addressed to the Chief Judge of the Seventeenth Judicial District.

This memo is not a revision or modification of any line of authority, it is only a codification of the terms under which the magistrate was hired.
