

SEVENTEENTH JUDICIAL DISTRICT
ADAMS COUNTY AND THE CITY AND COUNTY OF BROOMFIELD
ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE CHIEF JUDGE 2014-06 (Rev. 8/18)

The Adams County Sheriff's Department and the Broomfield Detention Center are hereby authorized to grant personal recognizance bonds (P. R. Bonds) for Contempt Warrants out of Division 1, Division 8, the Small Claims Division of the Adams County Courts, and Division 1 and the Small Claims Division C of the Broomfield Courts, under the following circumstances:

- Any person arrested and transported to either the Adams County Jail or the Broomfield Detention Center may be granted a P. R. Bond upon the satisfactory completion of Rule 369, CRCP interrogatories.
- Adams County P.R. Bonds will be returnable in either Division 1, Division 8 or the Small Claims Division of the Adams County Court on the following Tuesday at 8:30 am.
- Broomfield P.R. Bonds will be returnable in Division 1 of the Broomfield County Court on the following Thursday at 9:00 am.

Any person who refuses to answer the interrogatories will be denied a P.R. Bond and held for video advisal under the cash/surety bond as originally set. Any person arrested on a "Cash Only, Defendant Only" bond will also be held for video advisal. A form set of interrogatories, with instructions, will be provided to the Adams County Sheriff and Broomfield Police. Whether or not the interrogatories have been satisfactorily completed for purposes of the P. R. Bond will be left to the sound discretion of the Adams County Sheriff and the Broomfield Police.


Any person appearing at the Adams County Justice Center on a "Contempt Warrant Only" will be escorted by a sheriff's officer to Division 1, Division 8 or the Small Claims Division to appear before the court and follow any further instructions from the court.

Any person appearing at the Broomfield Courthouse on a "Contempt Warrant Only" will be escorted by a police officer to the main clerk's window to complete their interrogatories. Once completed, the Court may authorize a P.R. Bond with a return date.

Any party refusing to complete the interrogatories will be taken into custody and will follow the previous order to be released.
