NOTIFICATION IN ESTATES INVOLVING POLISH NATIONALS

Whenever it appears from documents and papers on file in any probate matter that any person having an interest in any estate under the jurisdiction of the probate court is a national of Poland residing outside the United States, notice of that fact shall be transmitted by letter, with a copy inserted in the decedent's estate file, to the Consular General of the Polish People's Republic.* The notice will identify the court, the case number, the name of the decedent, and the names and addresses of any heirs or persons who are Polish nationals.

The Consular General will be advised that he is being notified pursuant to the Consular Convention between the Polish People's Republic and the United States of America signed in May, 1972.
