The hiring freeze instituted on September 21, 1991, has not resulted in the desired level of reductions in the personal services budget of the Judicial Department. In order to further reduce the personal services expenditures, the following voluntary furlough program is instituted:

1. Employees who take a voluntary furlough after April 1 and prior to June 30, 1992, may convert sick leave to personal leave on the following schedule in fiscal year 1993.
