DIRECTIVE CONCERNING ASSIGNMENT OF JUVENILE COURT JUDGES TO HEAR CERTAIN PROBATE MATTERS

To promote judicial efficiency, the prompt disposition of judicial business, and to serve the best interests of the child, when the Denver Juvenile Court otherwise has jurisdiction over a child, any judge of the Denver Juvenile Court is hereby assigned to hear any matter affecting such child, which is otherwise within the jurisdiction of the Denver Probate Court.

The presiding judges of the Denver Probate Court and the Denver Juvenile Court shall develop procedures to promptly effect such assignment.
