[D-15] ORDER FOR COMPETENCY EVALUATION	

This matter comes before the Court pursuant to Stauch's Motion Raising Competency Pursuant to C.R.S. §16-8.5-101 et seq.


This matter proceeded to a hearing on June 5, 2020. The Court reviewed the Motion prior to the time of that hearing. Upon consideration of the matters set forth in the Motion, the Court FINDS and ORDERS as follows:

- (1) Pursuant to C.R.S. §16-8.5-103(2), the Court FINDS it has insufficient information to make a preliminary finding that the Defendant is competent. As such, the Court ORDERS that the Defendant be evaluated by the Colorado Department of Human Services for purposes of establishing competency;
- (2) Pursuant to C.R.S. §16-8.5-105(1)(b)(III), the Court FINDS extraordinary circumstances relating to the case or the Defendant make conducting the competency evaluation on an **INPATIENT BASIS** necessary and appropriate. Because of this finding, the Court also FINDS Defendant should be classified as a "**Tier I**" patient as that phrase is used in C.R.S. §16-8.5-101(19)(a);
- (3) If the Defendant is determined by the CDHS to be incompetent, the prosecution OBJECTS to the immediate commencement of restoration as provided by C.R.S. §16-8.5-105(1)(b.5);
- (4) Pursuant to C.R.S. §16-8.5-105(1)(a)(II), the Court ORDERS the parties to transmit collateral materials to the CDHS within 24 hours after the issuance of this Order with a certificate of service to the Court and other parties;

(5) The People have requested and the Court ORDERS the competency evaluation be video recorded pursuant to C.R.S. §16-8-106(1)(b) and -108(1)(a).
