First Judicial District Court judge finalists selected *Governor to appoint new district court judge*

The First Judicial District Nominating Commission has nominated three candidates for a district court judgeship created by the resignation of the Hon. Robert Lochary. The vacancy will occur on July 29, 2023. Nominees Chantel Contiguglia of Centennial, Christopher Blake Rhamey of Arvada, and Marianne Tims of Littleton were selected by the commission on June 14, 2023.

Under the Colorado Constitution, the governor has 15 days from June 15, 2023, within which to appoint one of the nominees as district court judge for the First Judicial District (Gilpin and Jefferson counties).
