Governor Polis Appoints Meegan A. Miloud to the First Judicial District Court

DENVER - Today, Governor Jared Polis appointed Meegan A. Miloud to the First Judicial District Court. The vacancy was created by the retirement of the Honorable Laura A. Tighe and is effective March 1, 2023.

Ms. Miloud is a District Court Magistrate in the 1st Judicial District, a position she has held since 2020. Her docket consists of probate, mental health, domestic relations, and juvenile matters.
