Jefferson County Court judge finalists selected Governor to appoint new county court judge

The First Judicial District Nominating Commission has nominated three candidates for a

Jefferson County court judgeship created by the retirement of the Honorable K.J. Moore,

effective Oct. 31, 2022. Nominees Keith Gorman of Littleton, and Christopher Rhamey and

Amber St. Clair, both of Arvada, were selected in a meeting on Sept. 30, 2022, at the Jefferson

County Courthouse.

Under the Colorado Constitution, the governor has 15 days from Oct. 4, 2022, within

which to appoint one of the nominees as county court judge for Jefferson County.
