Sixth Judicial District Court judge finalists selected *Governor to appoint new district court judge*

The Sixth Judicial District Nominating Commission has nominated three candidates for a district court judgeship created by the resignation of the Hon. Todd P. Norvell. The vacancy will occur on Jan. 14, 2023. Nominees Anthony Baca of Dolores, Anthony Edwards of Silverton, and Justin Fay of Pagosa Springs were selected by the commission on Dec. 20, 2022.

Under the Colorado Constitution, the governor has 15 days from Dec. 21, 2022, within which to appoint one of the nominees as district court judge for the Sixth Judicial District (Archuleta, La Plata and San Juan counties).
