Tenth Judicial District Court judge finalists selected *Governor to appoint new district court judge*

The Tenth Judicial District Nominating Commission has nominated three candidates for a district court judgeship. The judgeship was created by the retirement of the Hon. Kim Karn. The vacancy will occur on July 1, 2021.

Nominees Steven Laman, Timothy O'Shea, and Margaret Vellar, all of Pueblo, were selected by the commission on April 27, 2021.

Under the Colorado Constitution, the governor has 15 days from April 28, 2021, within which to appoint one of the nominees for the position of district court judge for the Tenth Judicial District (Pueblo County).
