Rio Grande County Court judge finalists selected *Governor to appoint new county court judge*

The Twelfth Judicial District Nominating Commission has nominated three candidates for a Rio Grande County Court judgeship created by the resignation of the Hon. Barbara A. Zollars. The vacancy will occur on June 1, 2022. Nominees Mark I. Loy and John W. Stenger, both of Del Norte; and Trayson N. Stephany of Lakewood were selected in a meeting on April 15, 2022.

Under the Colorado Constitution, the governor has 15 days from April 18, 2022, within which to appoint one of the nominees as county court judge for Rio Grande County.
