Crowley County Court judge finalists selected Governor to appoint new county court judge

The Sixteenth Judicial District Nominating Commission has nominated three candidates

for a Crowley County Court judgeship created by the retirement of the Hon. Richard Medina.

The vacancy will occur on June 1, 2023. Nominees Marcus Behm of Denver, Jeremy Boyce of

Greeley, and Tobin Wright of Swink were selected in a meeting on April 19, 2023.

Under the Colorado Constitution, the governor has 15 days from April 20, 2023, within

which to appoint one of the nominees as county court judge for Crowley County.
