16th Judicial District Court judge finalists selected *Governor to appoint new district court judge*

The Sixteenth Judicial District Nominating Commission has nominated three candidates for a district court judgeship created by the retirement of the Hon. Michael A. Schiferl. The vacancy will occur on July 2, 2022. Nominees William J. Culver of Rocky Ford, Rodney D. Fouracre Sr. of La Junta, and Samuel S. Vigil of Las Animas were selected by the commission on May 25, 2022.

Under the Colorado Constitution, the governor has 15 days from May 26, 2022, within which to appoint one of the nominees as district court judge for the Sixteenth Judicial District (Bent, Crowley and Otero counties).
