Broomfield County Court judge finalists selected Governor to appoint new county court judge

The Seventeenth Judicial District Nominating Commission has nominated three candidates for a Broomfield County Court judgeship created by the retirement of the Hon. Amy E. Bockman. The vacancy occurred on March 15, 2021. Nominees Amanda DeWick, Trevor Moritzky and Jacque Lyn Russell, all of Broomfield, were selected in a videoconference meeting on March 17, 2021.

Under the Colorado Constitution, the governor has 15 days from March 18, 2021, within which to appoint one of the nominees as county court judge for Broomfield County.
