## **Adams County Court judge finalists selected** *Governor to appoint new county court judge*

The Seventeenth Judicial District Nominating Commission has nominated three candidates for an Adams County court judgeship created by the retirement of the Hon. Brian N. Bowen effective April 29, 2022. Nominees Marquez Ivey of Aurora, Lara Jimenez of Brighton, and Joshua Nowak of Thornton were selected during a videoconference meeting on March 30, 2022.

Under the Colorado Constitution, the governor has 15 days from March 31, 2022, within which to appoint one of the nominees as county court judge for Adams County.
