17th Judicial District Court judge finalists selected *Governor to appoint new district court judge*

The Seventeenth Judicial District Nominating Commission has nominated three candidates for a district court judgeship created by the retirement of the Hon. Katherine R. Delgado. The vacancy will occur on Jan. 10, 2023. Nominees Shelby L. Fyles of Aurora, Kelley R. Southerland of Denver, and Bradley V. Varmo of Thornton were selected by the commission on July 15, 2022.

Under the Colorado Constitution, the governor has 15 days from July 18, 2022, within which to appoint one of the nominees as district court judge for the Seventeenth Judicial District (Adams and Broomfield counties).
