17th Judicial District Court judge finalists selected Governor to appoint new district court judge

The Seventeenth Judicial District Nominating Commission has nominated three candidates for a district court judgeship created by the retirement of the Hon. Robert W. Kiesnowski Jr. The vacancy will occur on July 1, 2023. Nominees Jeffrey D. Ruff of Denver, Sarah Elizabeth Stout of Erie, and Bradley Victor Varmo of Thornton were selected by the commission on May 30, 2023.

Under the Colorado Constitution, the governor has 15 days from May 31, 2023, within which to appoint one of the nominees as district court judge for the Seventeenth Judicial District (Adams and Broomfield counties).
