Governor Polis Appoints Benjamin T. Figa to 18th Judicial District Court

DENVER - Governor Jared Polis appointed Benjamin T. Figa to the 18th Judicial District Court. The vacancy is created by the retirement of the Honorable David J. Stevens and is effective July 1, 2022.

Mr. Figa is Special Counsel at Burns, Figa & Will P.C., a position he has held since 2018. His practice consists primarily of litigation. Previously, he was an Assistant City Attorney for the City and County of Denver (2015-2017); Deputy Legal Counsel for the Office of Governor John W.
