Douglas County Court judge finalists selected *Governor to appoint new county court judge*

The Eighteenth Judicial District Nominating Commission has nominated three candidates for a Douglas County court judgeship created by the retirement of the Hon. Susanna Meissner-Cutler. The vacancy will occur on May 8, 2021. Nominees Victoria Cisneros of Denver, Phelicia Kossie-Butler of Aurora, and Kelly Waidler of Parker were selected in a meeting on March 24, 2021.

Under the Colorado Constitution, the governor has 15 days from March 25, 2021, within which to appoint one of the nominees as county court judge for Douglas County.
