Arapahoe County Court judge finalists selected *Governor to appoint new county court judge*

The Eighteenth Judicial District Nominating Commission has nominated three candidates for an Arapahoe County Court judgeship created by the resignation of the Hon. Anne M. Ollada. The vacancy will occur on July 1, 2022. Nominees Christina M. Apostoli, LaQunya L. Baker, and Michael J. Carter, all of Aurora, were selected in a meeting on May 17, 2022.

Under the Colorado Constitution, the governor has 15 days from May 18, 2022, within which to appoint one of the nominees as county court judge for Arapahoe County.
