19th Judicial District Court judge finalists selected Governor to appoint new district court judge

The Nineteenth Judicial District Nominating Commission has nominated three candidates for a district court judgeship created by the retirement of the Honorable James F. Hartmann, effective Oct. 1, 2022. Nominees Anita Crowther of Erie, Audrey Galloway of Windsor, and Eang Man of Cheyenne, WY were selected by the commission on Aug 12, 2022, at the Weld County Courthouse.

Under the Colorado Constitution, the governor has 15 days from Aug. 15, 2022, within which to appoint one of the nominees as district court judge for the Nineteenth Judicial District (Weld County).
