19th Judicial District Court judge finalists selected *Governor to appoint new district court judge*

The Nineteenth Judicial District Nominating Commission has nominated three candidates for a district court judgeship created by the retirement of the Hon. Thomas J. Quammen, effective July 31, 2021. Nominees Allison Esser of Fort Collins, Audrey Galloway of Windsor, and Jerry Manzer Jr. of Greeley were selected by the commission on June 9, 2021.

Under the Colorado Constitution, the governor has 15 days from June 10, 2021, within which to appoint one of the nominees as district court judge for the Nineteenth Judicial District (Weld County).
