## **Weld County Court judge finalists selected** *Governor to appoint new county court judge*

The Nineteenth Judicial District Nominating Commission has nominated three candidates for a Weld County court judgeship created by the retirement of the Honorable Charles Unfug, effective Jan. 10, 2023. Nominees Sarah Babb of Windsor, Renee Doak of Severance and Havilah Lilly of Firestone were selected in a meeting on Aug. 1, 2022, at the Weld County Courthouse.

Under the Colorado Constitution, the governor has 15 days from Aug. 2, 2022, within which to appoint one of the nominees as county court judge for Weld County.
