20th Judicial District Court judge finalists selected Governor to appoint new district court judge

The Twentieth Judicial District Nominating Commission has nominated three candidates

for a district court judgeship created by the retirement of the Hon. Andrew R. Macdonald. The

vacancy will occur on April 1, 2021. Nominees James "Keith" Collins and Monica Haenselman,

both of Boulder; and Dea Lindsey of Firestone were selected by the commission on March 1,

2021.

Under the Colorado Constitution, the governor has 15 days from March 2, 2021, within

which to appoint one of the nominees as district court judge for the Twentieth Judicial District

(Boulder County).
