21st Judicial District Court judge finalists selected Governor to appoint new district court judge

The Twenty-first Judicial District Nominating Commission has nominated three candidates for a district court judgeship created by the resignation of the Hon. Lance Timbreza, effective Sept. 12, 2022. Nominees Jeremy Chaffin, Michael Grattan, III., and Jennifer Springer, all of Grand Junction, were selected by the commission on Oct. 7, 2022.

Under the Colorado Constitution, the governor has 15 days from Oct. 10, 2022, within which to appoint one of the nominees as district court judge for the Twenty-first Judicial District (Mesa County).
