## 22<sup>nd</sup> Judicial District Court judge finalists selected Governor to appoint new district court judge

The Twenty-second Judicial District Nominating Commission has nominated two candidates for a district court judgeship created by the retirement of the Honorable Douglas S. Walker, effective Jan. 10, 2023. Nominees William Y. Furse of Dolores, and JenniLynn Lawrence of Mancos were selected by the commission on Aug. 15, 2022, at the Montezuma County Courthouse.

Under the Colorado Constitution, the governor has 15 days from Aug. 15, 2022, within which to appoint one of the nominees as district court judge for the Twenty-second Judicial District (Dolores and Montezuma counties).
