Upon consideration of the public and media interest in the proceedings in this matter and the current Covid-19 pandemic, the Court, in the exercise of its inherent power to provide for the safe and orderly disposition of this case, hereby enters this Order pertaining to the gathering and conduct of proceedings in this matter.

Those unable to enter the courtroom because of space limitations may proceed to the Jury Assembly Room, W113 on Friday, June 5, 2020 at 9:00 a.m. for a status conference. All entrance into the space will be through the most westerly doors closest to the First Appearance Center (the second entry door into the Jury Assembly Room as approaching from the exterior of the space).

All exit from the space will be through the most easterly doors of the jury room closest to the main entrance.

Anyone entering the Jury Assembly Room will be subject to mandatory questioning re: Covid-19 symptoms. Anyone who provides information that they are currently exhibiting symptoms or have had recent exposure to a Covid-19 positive individual will be restricted from entry.

All persons entering the Jury Assembly Room will be ordered to wear a mask throughout the entirety of the proceeding and at all other times while inside the Jury Assembly Room. Masks will be provided for those who do not arrive with their own mask.

No more than 50 people will be allowed into the Jury Assembly Room. All persons are ordered to maintain a 6-foot distance between themselves and any other person not in their household group.

One person per group entering the Jury Assembly Room shall provide personal contact information to the Court representative present in the Jury Assembly Room.

All individuals vulnerable to Covid-19 are requested to not attend this proceeding for their own safety.

There shall be no recording of any kind of these proceedings.
