Presiding Disciplinary Judge finalists selected *Supreme Court to appoint new Presiding Disciplinary Judge*

The Supreme Court Advisory Committee on the Practice of Law has nominated three candidates for the Presiding Disciplinary Judge vacancy created by the retirement of the Hon. William R. Lucero. The vacancy will occur on May 31, 2022. Nominees Bryon Large, Carey Markel and Joseph Michaels were selected by the committee on March 17, 2022.

The Supreme Court intends to appoint a new presiding disciplinary judge by April 15, 2022.
