14th Judicial District announces Moffat County Court vacancy Commission sets date to select nominees

The Fourteenth Judicial District Nominating Commission will meet via videoconference on Jan. 12, 2024, to interview and select nominees for appointment by the governor to the office of county judge for Moffat County. The vacancy will be created by the Hon. Brittany A. Schneider's appointment to the District Court. The vacancy will occur on Jan. 1, 2024.

To be eligible, the applicant must be a qualified elector of Moffat County at the time of investiture and have graduated high school or attained the equivalent of a high school education as indicated by the Department of Education, based upon the record made on the General Education Development test. The annual salary for this position is \$110,822.40, and it is a 60 percent position. The initial term of office of a county judge is a provisional term of two years; thereafter, the incumbent county judge, if approved by the voters, has a term of four years.

The completed application must be e-mailed to the address listed in the instructions below no later than 4 p.m. on Dec. 22, 2023. Late applications will not be considered. Any person wishing to suggest a candidate to fill the vacancy may do so by letter to be submitted to any member of the nominating commission, with a copy to the ex officio chair, no later than 4 p.m. on Dec. 15, 2023. Under the rules of the 14th Judicial District Nominating Commission, names of the applicants shall be made public once the application period is closed.

The members of the nominating commission for the Fourteenth Judicial District are: Staci Nichols of Craig; Sandra Doudna of Grand Lake; and Casey Quillen, Ryan Dougherty, and Linda "Lulu" Gould of Steamboat Springs. The commission has two vacancies.

The application and any attachments must be submitted as a single PDF file with reference letters attached last. The application should be in text searchable format. It is preferred that reference letters are included with your application submission. However, if they are submitted directly by the author, they must be submitted by email as described below in paragraph 3. All letters of reference are due by the filing deadline listed in paragraph 4.
