## **19<sup>th</sup> Judicial District Court judge finalists selected** *Governor to appoint new district court judge*

The 19<sup>th</sup> Judicial District Nominating Commission has nominated three candidates for a district court judgeship created by the retirement of the Hon. Meghan Saleebey. The vacancy occurred on April 27, 2024. Nominees Cara Michelle Boxberger of Severance, Daniel Ralph Delaney of Erie, and Audrey A. Galloway of Windsor were selected by the commission on May 1, 2024.

Under the Colorado Constitution, the governor has 15 days from May 2, 2024, within which to appoint one of the nominees as district court judge for the 19<sup>th</sup> Judicial District (Weld County).
