18th Judicial District Court judge finalists selected

Governor to appoint new district court judge

The Eighteenth Judicial District Nominating Commission has nominated three candidates for a district court judgeship created by the resignation of the Hon. Cajardo R. Lindsey. The vacancy will occur on September 4, 2024. Nominees Niceta E. Bradburn of Parker, Robert E. Caldwell, Jr. and Christine A. Washburn, both of Centennial, were selected by the commission on July 29, 2024, during a meeting at the Arapahoe County Justice Center.

Under the Colorado Constitution, the governor has 15 days from July 30, 2024, to appoint one of the nominees as a district court judge for the Eighteenth Judicial District (Arapahoe, Douglas, Elbert and Lincoln counties).
