## MR. ALISSA'S MOTION TO CONTINUE THE AUGUST 6, 2024 MOTIONS HEARING (D-064)

Mr. Alissa, through counsel, respectfully requests this Court continue his motions hearing scheduled for August 6, 2024. In support of this motion, counsel states the following.

- 1. Mr. Alissa is set for a half-day motions hearing on August 6, 2024. There are a number of outstanding motions that will be addressed at that hearing.
- 2. He passed away unexpectedly from an unknown medical issue, leaving behind this counselor's sister and two young children.
- 3. This counselor flew to Minnesota on July 31, 2024 to be with her family during this extremely difficult time.
- 4. Services for this counselor's brother in-law are on Tuesday August 6 and Wednesday August 7, 2024 in Minnesota.
