The jury process for the 20th Judicial District begins when the Jury Commissioner essentially places an order for summons, otherwise known as a jury call. In this case, an order was placed for 375 summonses for each wave of jurors. JPOD randomly takes 375 names from the Boulder pool and mails those people a summons. At the time the jurors were summoned on this case, the pool had 219,223 available people remaining in the pool and a total of 1500 people were summoned. This information can be confirmed with the Jury Commissioner.

In terms of the 20th Judicial District pool, that is a product of the process done by the State Court Administrator's Office and the annual creation of a "jury wheel." For this process, please see the Attachment to this Order.
